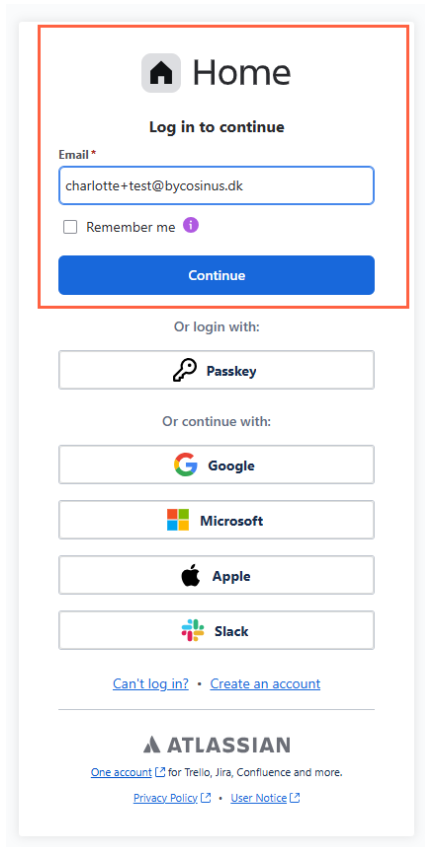


Atlassian Cloud Home: Sign-in procedure

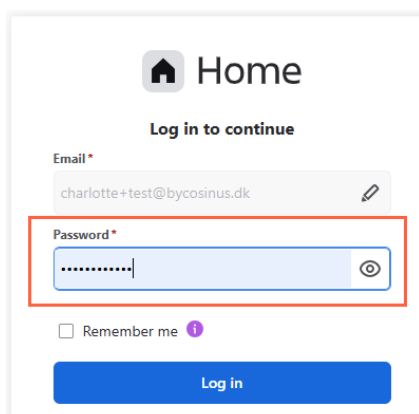
1. Go to <https://stibodx.atlassian.net>
2. Enter your email address:

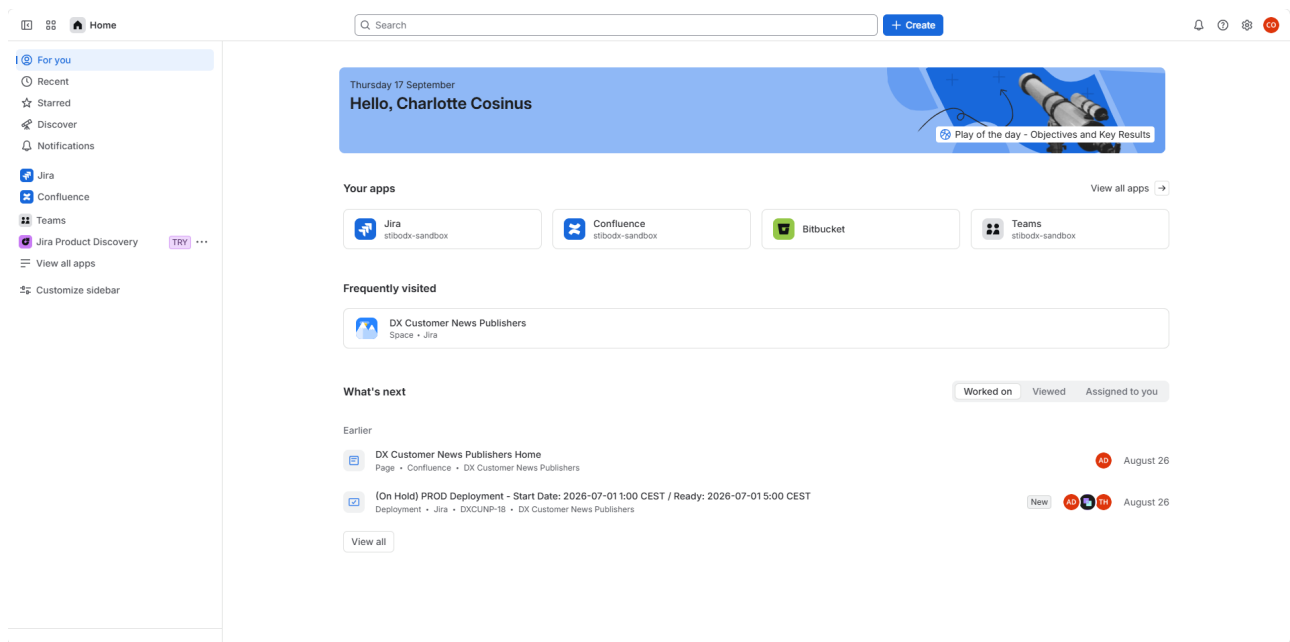

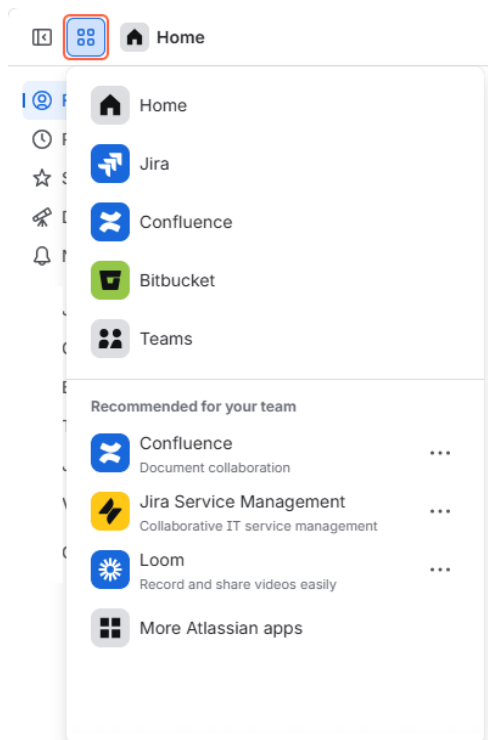

You are now logged in to the Atlassian **Home** page.



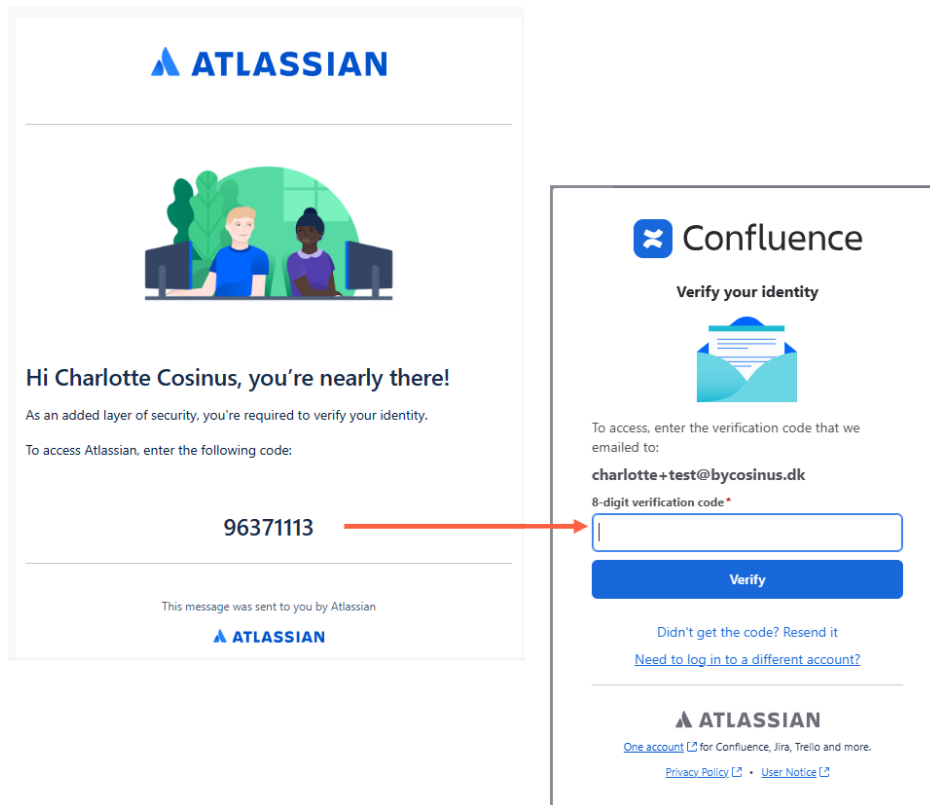
From here, you can use the  button drop-down list to access the various Atlassian applications, e.g. Jira and Confluence, you usually have access to:



As a security measure, Stibo DX requires an additional layer of verification when signing in to the single Atlassian Cloud applications.

This means that when you select an Atlassian application, you are asked to verify your identity, either by email verification code or by an authentication app, depending on what you have selected the first time you signed in.

In the example below, an email code is used:



After your identity has been verified, you are signed in to the selected application.

Session Expiration

Please note that your session expires after 24 hours. As a result, if you use the application daily, you will need to sign in again each day.

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
